





## Paid Work Opportunities

The Workforce Connection offers opportunities for you to hire qualified individuals and we can subsidize the pay in two different ways! The On-the-Job training and Work Experience programs offer you the chance to hire, train, and retain employees with funding for their wages.

Our On-the-Job training (OJT) and Work Experience (WEX) programs could be right for your business!

## Work Experience (WEX)

The Work Experience program provides employers with pre-screened candidates who need new or recent job experience and can fill a role at your business temporarily.

- The Workforce Connection pays all wages taxes, and associated costs, including workers compensation.
- We work with you to design a training and employment plan for the participant.
- They work for up to 25 hours per week for up to 14 weeks.
- You are welcome to hire them upon completion, yet not required to do so.

## On the Job Training (OJT)

The On-the-Job training program provides employers with candidates for your positions that may need some training to master the expectations of the position.

- Your business hires the participant and The Workforce Connection will reimburse you for up to 75% of wages for the training period.
- We work with you to design a training and employment plan for the participant.
- They participant works full time for your business at the hours/shifts that work for you.
